Thank you for your understanding and cooperation as we continue to be operating at alert level 2. We realise that this is impacting on some of our school activities but we are managing to keep them to a real minimum.

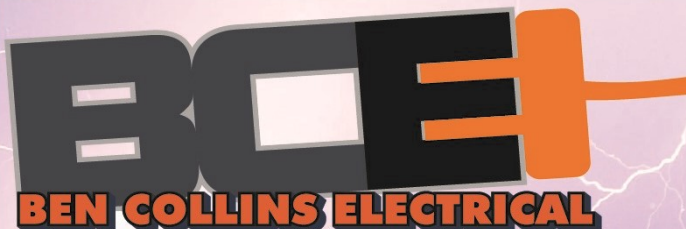
