PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

We began this week with teacher training to enable staff to teach the Pause Breathe Smile programme. This programme was developed in 2013, and has sound research to support the claims it makes.

'Pause Breathe Smile teaches mindfulness as a life skill for the purposes of:

- Improving focus and attention
- Increasing care for self and others
- Developing emotional regulation skills and the ability to self-calm
- Improving a child's ability to make wise choices about what supports wellbeing and what doesn't
- Developing emotional literacy and boosting resilience
- Cultivating a positive sense of connection to self, others and the natural world'

This programme is tried and tested. We can see how it will have a positive impact on the capacity of learners at Manawaru School.

We are excited that the Te Aroha Kaahui Ako primary schools, and a few Te Aroha College teachers are all involved in this training. This will be another way we can support the Te Aroha learner, using a proven common sense programme. We will be involving families as much as we can, because we know when we all work together we get the best results. Don't expect your children to come home singing Kumbaya; it is definitely not that sort of programme! ③


