PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

Crazy though it seems, the pool has seen action, as the school participated in the SwimSafe programme, supported by Matamata-Piako District Council and is run through Swimzone in Matamata. This week long programme was rated highly by the Manawaru Team. What an amazing opportunity to start the swimming season at Manawaru School. Thanks once again to the Fundraising Team at Manawaru School for creating the warm, safe pool environment. Thanks also to Dave Johnston, from Shackell Electrical for his efforts. Thanks also to all the parents bravely popping togs and towels in bags daily. We will be sensible with your children! :)

We are in the process of sorting out the hiring of school keys for the pool. We are sure there will be families keen to support swimming practice over the holidays, to ensure everyone is safe in the water. We are looking at a support team for the pool, some emergency contacts and some people to pop Carlos, our pool vacuum, in and out of the water. The BOT has decided to keep prices the same as several years ago. It is a good way for the school to thank the community for all of the support they show the school. So keep an eye out, we will let you know when we are set to go.

Thanks also to the Fundraising Team who are paying \$15-00 per child for Beach Education this year. This day is filled with learning for everyone, so we hope there will be lots of parents supporting the day. We attend Beach Education every second year only, so it is important that everyone participates. The children don't go deeply into the water, and there is a safety ring of adults containing them while they are in the water. A large part of the day is spent on dry land, looking at how to read the sea, so the day is useful to all! We would quite like to maximise the opportunity for everyone to stay alive in the water!

Planning for Senior camp (years 5-8) is underway, with a Science focus designed for the 2024 camp. Information about camp will be coming out shortly, but if you google Camp Awesome in Raglan you will get a good idea of the adventures ahead. This should be a great experience, developing our learners into confident young people, ready for life's adventures. I would urge you to check out the information, and feel free to ask questions that will ensure you are best able to support your child's adventure!
