#### **PRINCIPAL'S REPORT**

Whilst I start to write this newsletter I'm looking out the office window to see the hustle and bustle of Outdoor Classroom Day.

Our children are warming themselves around a campfire, navigating around the school grounds using compasses, building huts and going on a fungi safari. Generally, just enjoying being with one another and being outside the classroom.

Outdoor Classroom Day is a global movement to inspire and celebrate outdoor play and learning. It originally started as Empty Classroom Day in London in 2012. It's quite an interesting story how this day came about. In a nutshell, data in a report stated that children (in London) were spending less time outdoors than ever before and this was affecting their health, wellbeing and development. Educators were quite disheartened, and began sharing memories of being outside as children.

One of them shared that their happiest childhood memory was getting an extended lunch break when she was about eight and that her teachers let them carry on making dens with the recently cut grass on the school field. What struck these educators was how simple this, and all the other memories, were. Just being outside. Being with other children. Getting out in all kinds of weather. They agreed they were sick of the bad news stories about children not going outside enough. It was time to create a good news story. After coming up with over hundreds of ideas, one shone out above all the others: Empty Classroom Day. 108 schools signed up to the first Empty Classroom Day and despite the frequent downpours on the day teachers were committed to making learning and playing outside fun – even in torrential rain. Word soon spread and by 2014 it became an international event and with a name change - Outdoor Classroom Day was born; a worldwide celebration of nurturing children and young people through nature. Today, over 9.6 million children and more than 105,000 teachers, parents and supporters have been involved around the world. Our children thoroughly enjoyed the day and they can't wait until we do it again!

Whilst we are on the subject of enjoying the outdoors Room 1 have a couple of eager students interested in trapping possums that are inhabiting the Gully. Possum traps have been purchased and the group are in great discussions on how and where they will be laid. Watch this space as we will keep you posted on how successful we are – apparently possum fur is a high commodity and sells for a good price! "We can get rich Miss Sargent" – direct quote from Matty.


