After Covid 19 close-down we are excited to announce that day holiday programmes will be back up and running in **July 2020** and camps will be back in **September/October**.

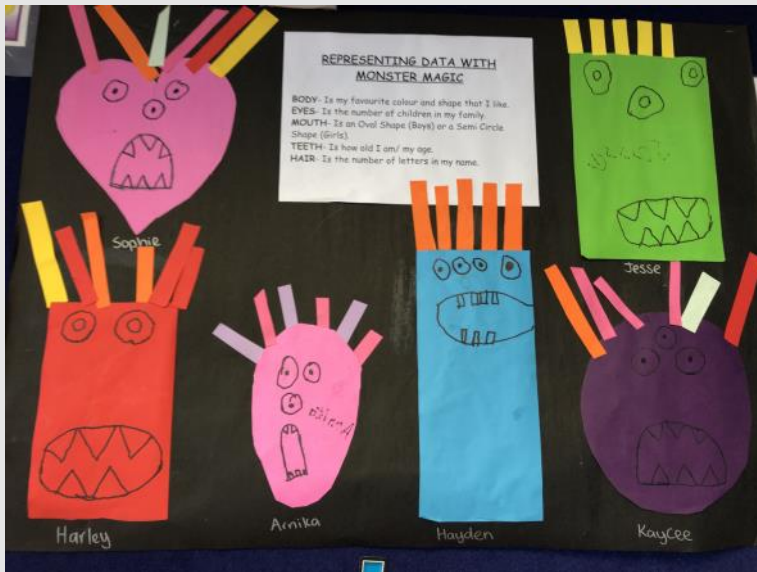

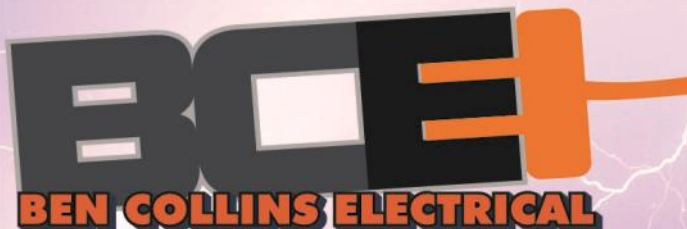
