PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

Kia ora

I trust that you all enjoyed a wonderful Labour weekend break with your whānau. The weather was beautiful, so I am sure that many of you got to make the most of the sunshine and fresh air! I can't believe we are at the end of week three already though – the term is flying by fast!

We are definitely on our way to that Summer weather so it seems appropriate to give everyone the Sunsmart reminder! Manawaru School is accredited as a Sunsafe School by the New Zealand Cancer Society. This means:

Parents need to be responsible for ensuring that children come to school appropriately prepared, i.e. with suitable clothing, with sunscreen SPF 30+ on, and with hats which are broad-brimmed (min 7.5 cms), legionnaire or bucket hats (min 6 cm. brim, deep crown) to wear when they are outside (e.g. interval, lunch, sport, excursions and activities) during Terms one and four.

'No Hat, Play in the Shade' policy. Children without hats will be required to play under the trees at

the front.

• Encourage children to wear clothing that protects the skin from the sun (e.g. sleeves and collars).

Sunhats are to be named and left at school!

We have seen some fantastic examples of good hats, caps with the flap protecting the back of the neck and lovely broad brimmed hats, so your children should know what we are looking for. Caps without the flap are not suitable as the ears and back of the neck are still exposed. It would be fabulous to see every child at school on Monday being Sunsmart.



This week we were once again reminded of what an amazing community of parents we have. Thank you very much to all of those parents who volunteered to help run our Athletic Sports Day and a big extra thank you to Sarah and her team of parents who arrived early at Herries Park and helped set up the equipment. Your help makes a big difference and we really do appreciate it. District Athletics this year will be held on Wednesday, 11 November at Herries Park and Thames Valley is Wednesday, 18 November at Whangamata Area School. You will be informed if your child qualifies for these events.
