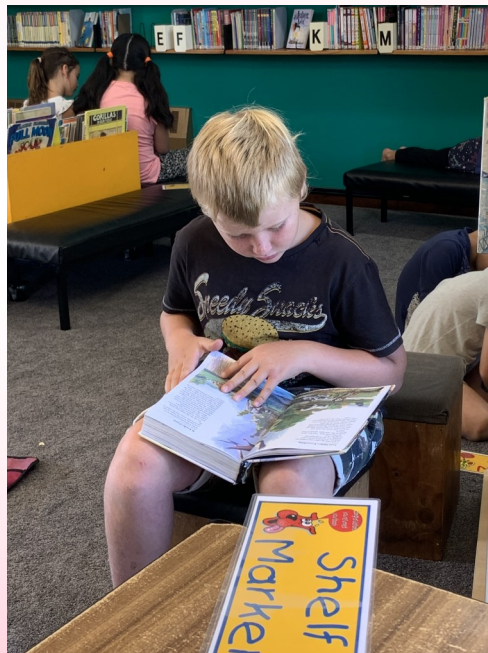




## We love our library!

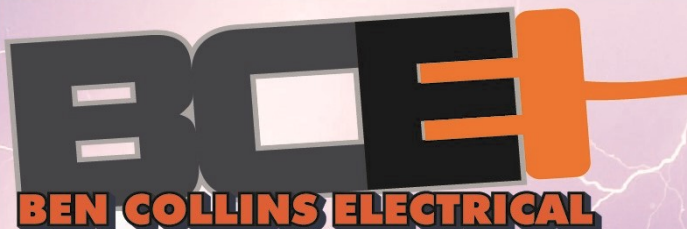
