PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

Welcome to those new to Manawaru. I am sure your time here will be unforgettable!

Every week seems more fun filled than the last! This past week has seen a few new challenges thrown our way. For the first time in a lot of years we were unable to staff a class, at the last minute. We have been fortunate that this hasn't happened earlier. Unfortunately it is more likely to become a regular feature of school life, a reflection of life today.

It was good to see parents making the time to meet with John Parsons, our cyber safety expert. I know that the meetings I went to were well tailored and had messages, that while they may have been hard to hear, were valuable. It was lovely to work in once again with our fellow Te Aroha schools.

I particularly warmed to his perspective that 'children are learning to make better choices' rather than making mistakes. His message definitely encouraged children to make safe choices in a number of manageable ways, and to reach out to others if they encounter an issue they are uncomfortable with. His work with parent groups was based on his understanding that 'parents are the guardians of their children'.

Next week we will be supporting his work with the Police Education Programme (KOS). This programme has been in schools for over 30 years. We are fortunate to have our Whaea Tash, from NZ police working with us to deliver the programme. Families will keep up with what is happening in rooms, with tasks being sent home in some rooms. Please keep an eye out, and remember to chat to your children when they come home.

As a result of the discussion John had with teachers we will be revising the way we work as teachers. While we try hard to focus on the child, rather than the guardian, it is easy to slip. So keep your eyes out for a few subtle changes.

John also talked about the Child Protection Policy. Just a reminder that currently all our policies are available on our Manawaru School Governance google site. We are currently signed up with Schooldocs, an organisation that ensures all policies meet all legal requirements, and I am working through them personalising them to Manawaru School. When that is completed everyone will be able to access them, with a password linked to the school.
