Restorative Practice—how we stay friendly at Manawaru School.

Every day teachers and students use the 5Fs. It's not a soft option - the process takes a lot of supported teaching and learning about emotions and actions, empathy and consequences.

Room 3 devised some dramatic freeze-frames to remind our community how we make it all work...



"When you're hurting someone or being mean and calling people names, that's a FOUL UP. Everybody makes these mistakes sometimes, even Mums and Dads."

"When you 'FESS UP, you own your mistake and you admit that you caused the hurt. Sometimes it is by accident, but you are not trying it blame it on someone else or say it was their idea."



"FRONT UP is when you say that you're sorry and show that you are sorry for your mistake. Shouting, "Sorry!" is not a good way to do it—that's just another Bucket Dipper!"

"If you break something you try to fix or replace it. A FIX UP is showing that you want to make things better. If you have hurt them, you ask if they need an ice-pack and get it for them."



"A FOLLOW UP is when you go to the person you hurt at the end of the day, and ask if they are all right. You could shake hands or give them a cuddle, if that's ok with them. You could ask, 'Are you feeling alright now, are we still friends?" We aren't BFFs with everyone, but we can be friendly to everyone."

It might seem simple, but it's Big Brain work!
