PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

Kia ora whanau

It is lovely to have all our tamariki back with us looking healthy and reenergised and ready for a new year of learning. I hope you have all had a very happy and relaxing holiday break with your children and that you have been able to enjoy the great New Zealand outdoors over a sun-filled summer. What a wonderful country New Zealand is. I was able to play travel guide to a visiting friend and discovered myself, some new favourite 'hang outs' including Lake Hakanoa which is in Huntly. It's worth a check out if you're over that way.

No doubt you would have seen recently in the news that the national monitoring of student achievement showed a low level of achievement for Year 8's in mathematics - only 45% were achieving at or above curriculum expectations. And perhaps you may be concerned about your child's achievement. Here at Manawaru we use PR1ME Mathematics. A programme that has been developed for NZ schools that combine the standards and best practices of South Korea, Singapore and Hong Kong, (the three top-performing education systems against international benchmarks on mathematics achievement).

This year marks the third year we will be running PR1ME in school and we are starting to see the changes we want in achievement. This year 89% of our leaving Year 8's were achieving at or above our curriculum expectations. The reason why we chose PR1ME was for its potential to enhance our students' mathematical success, and the impact it will have on them as life-long motivated mathematical learners. It is a well-structured programme that builds a solid foundation in maths by developing deep conceptual understanding with a strong focus on problem-solving.

It is clearly sequenced so that new concepts are regularly revisited, reinforced and built upon to enable children to confidently move to the next step of complexity in the concept or skill being learned. Of course just like reading, maths can be practised at home too. Times tables are a good place to start particularly those children who are working at Level 2B and beyond.

If you have any questions about your child's learning please contact their classroom teacher.

Thanks for sorting out the gear they need for school. Remember we need to swim your children every day to ensure they can swim to survive by the time they leave us. So it goes without saying that they need to bring their togs to school every day. Swimming Sports is in Week 5 – a google form will be sent to you via HERO next week to fill in for permission and transport. Please submit this asap.

Please remember to contact the office if your children will not be taking the school bus home in the afternoon. It helps us when we are calling the bus roll.

We are all looking forward to 2021 - a year full of learning!
